**Papal Visit** We have been advised of our allocation of tickets for the Papal visit (124) along with guidelines (some of which are listed below) for those attending:

- All pilgrims will need to be in place in Bellahouston Park by 3pm
- The Mass will begin at 5.15pm and conclude by 7.30pm. However, due to the large numbers in attendance it will take some hours to empty the Park. Please note that by 7.30pm it will be dark
- Arrival and departure times for coaches will be staggered to ensure they meet necessary deadlines and ensure a flow of traffic
- The park will be exposed and there will be no weather protection. Pilgrims must be physically able to cope with this
- Seating will not be provided at the venue
- No person under the age of 18 can be allocated an invitation without evidence that they will have appropriate supervision
- Provided prior notification is given, individual provision will be made for persons permanently confined to a wheelchair
- Provision will be made for those who use sign language
- All pilgrims from our Parish must travel together in the buses provided, under the direction of the Parish Pilgrim Leader

Fr. Joe wishes to ensure as many young people as possible from our Parish can attend, so all those under 18 will travel free of charge.

Calum MacAuley has been asked and kindly agreed to be our Parish Pilgrim Leader. One of the duties of the Pilgrim Leader is to collate, for security purposes, the following information for those attending:
