Appointment of New Archbishop Archbishop Mario has written to the Priests of the Diocese advising that he expects a new Archbishop to be appointed towards the beginning of next year. It is open to any member of the faithful to write to the Apostolic Nuncio with any ideas or suggestions which they might have

Papal Visit After the formal reception by the Queen at the Palace of Holyrood House the Holy Father will go via Princes Street. Ahead of his motorcade there will be a pageant. This will be Scottish in character reflecting both our Christian history, the life of St. Ninian, whose Feast day it will be, and our traditional dress and music with a march past of pipe bands. The numbers who will be able to participate in the Mass at Bellahouston will be in the region of 80,000 to 120,000, though the final figure has not yet been agreed.

Reopening of the Cathedral It is hoped that the reconsecration of the Cathedral will take place towards the end of November. Peter Howson, the distinguished Scottish artist, has painted St. John Ogilvie and made a gift of his painting to the Cathedral. It was for the celebration of the Mass and his faithfulness to the spiritual authority of the Holy Father on matters of faith and morals that St. John Ogilvie was arrested, tortured and judicially executed. This generous gift by the artist reflects his importance in the life of the Catholic Church in Scotland
