Euthanasia Bill There is currently a bill before the Scottish Parliament legalising euthanasia. MSPs have informed that there has been very little lobbying against the bill and there is therefore a very real likelihood that it will move forward because we have failed to let our opposition be known. opposition, Archbishop Conti would like two delegates from the parish who would be willing to attend an information talk on the bill and take responsibility for raising awareness of the issue and the steps which can be taken in each parish.
