Message from Mgr. Peter Smith re Papal Mass - Thursday 16th

Sept 2010 - Bellahouston In
view of the article in the Scottish
Catholic Observer, Msgr. Smith
has written to emphasise that there
is no difference between Scotland
and England in the process to
cover costs associated with
transport etc. The arrangements
for covering transport costs and
materials for pilgrims are **exactly**
the same in both Scotland and in
England. The suggestion that
pilgrims are paying for Mass in
England is inaccurate. The plans
are for transport costs to be shared
over the entire country so as to
exercise a degree of solidarity for
those travelling furthest. In
addition, there will be a Pilgrim
Pack for everyone attending
which will include various items
to assist the pilgrims including a
CD and a liturgy book which will
cover the entire visit by His
Holiness, including the events in
England. We therefore suggest a
donation equivalent to £20 per
pilgrim for everyone attending
Bellahouston. For this same
reason of solidarity Pilgrims who
want to travel from Scotland to
e.g. Birmingham will be requested
to make the same donation as
someone living in Birmingham
i.e. £25. It will be left to the
parish to decide how to deal with
this. This again, is exactly the
same as the plans for the events in
England. Hopefully we can avoid
further misunderstandings as we
prepare to greet the Holy Father in
seven weeks time.

Message from Fr. Joe Dear
brothers and sisters, our
pilgrimage to Lourdes is now
coming to a close. If the weather
has developed a Scottish hue, it
has not dampened the spirits of
the pilgrims at all and there is a

general feeling that we have
experienced abundant graces and
blessings from God!

Last Sunday we had the privilege
of celebrating Mass in English at
the Grotto of Massabiele where, in
1858, Our Blessed Lady appeared
to St. Bernadette Soubirous on 18
occasions. Her messages were
always very brief.

On the occasion of the 8th
Apparition, 24th. Feb: "*Penance!
Penance! Penance! Pray to God
for sinners. Kiss the ground as an
act of penance for sinners!*"

On the occasion of the 8th
Apparition, 2nd March "*Go, tell
the priests to come here in
procession and to build a chapel
here.*"

During the 16th Apparition, 25th.
March: The vision finally revealed
her name, "*She lifted up her eyes
to heaven, joined her hands as
though in prayer, that were held
out and open towards the ground
and said to me: Que soy era
Immaculada Concepciou (I am
the Immaculate Conception).*"

The theme of the Pilgrimages this
year is the Sign of the Cross.
Bernadette was herself unable to
make this sign until Our Lady did
so. The manner in which our
blessed Lady made the Sign of the
Cross made a life long impression
on her. To the end of her days.
She never ceased to make this
sign except with the utmost
reverence and respect.

in prayer to Our Lady of Lourdes
you are uniting yourselves to the
prayers offered at Lourdes.
