Monday 31st May – Feast of the Visitation of Our Lady – Day for Life

Please do all you can to take part in the Mass on Monday evening at 7pm as here in Scotland we offer up a day of penance & prayer asking God to bring to an end the greatest evil in our world, namely the killing of the unborn child. The second collection this Sunday will be used to help to finance the work of the Church in seeking to combat this evil through scientific research and debate. Please be as generous as you can.

Sunday 6th June – Solemnity of Corpus Christi

During this day, to help us to deepen our faith in the Eucharist and our devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, there will be adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 3pm until 4.30pm when it will conclude with Benediction. We will also have, after the 11am Mass, a procession of the Blessed Sacrament round the church, led by the First Communion children. The second collection at this Mass will be for the Papal visit. Whilst the Government is responsible for the major portion of the costs, since it is an official State visit, they are not responsible for the costs relating to the religious events. Since the visit is to Great Britain and Northern Ireland, tickets for events in Scotland will need to be open to people from the whole country and the costs of the visit

are being shared by the Catholic Church in Great Britain. The overall cost to us as a Church will be in the region of £7 million, a large part of which will relate to security, the demands of which are quite extraordinary. While most of us will be unable to be present at the Mass in Bellahouston because the numbers are so restricted, please try to understand that it cannot be like the last time. Please be as generous as you can in supporting this most important visit for our country and for our Church.

Sunday 13th June I will be celebrating the marriage of a friend in St. James' Church, St. Andrew's, Fife, on Saturday afternoon 12th June. Msgr. Peter McGhee, a priest of Galloway diocese who is presently serving as the Officialis of the Scottish Tribunal, has kindly agreed to cover the Mass on Saturday evening at 6pm and on Sunday at 11am. I will be back for the 5pm Mass on Sunday evening. The second collection on this Sunday is for the Assisted Parishes of the Diocese.

Sunday 20th June The second collection this week will be for St. Peter's Pence. This is the annual collection which is taken up to help our Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI, in running the Vatican and dispensing charitable contributions in the name of the Church to particular emergency situations as they arise during the course of the year.

Sunday 27th June This weekend the Mass will be covered by a Priest of the Holy Ghost Fathers and will be our annual Mission appeal. That same Sunday I will have the pleasure of taking part in the 11am Mass at St. Philomena's, Provanmill, when my older brother John, Canon John McAuley, will be celebrating the 40th anniversary of his ordination to the Priesthood.
